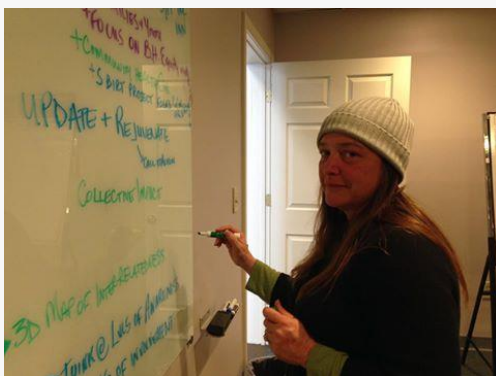
Collaborative News
